ANNEXURE – 'B'

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR ENGAGEMENT OF JUNIOR ENGINEERS
(CIVIL) ON CONTRACTUAL BASIS UNDER WORKS DEPARTMENT.**

- i. No traveling allowance is allowed to join the place of engagement of the Junior Engineer (Civil).
- ii. The engagement is purely on contract basis and the contractual engagement will be up to 28th February 2014 A.N. and may be renewed subject to necessity of Government and satisfactory performance of the individual incumbent. In absence of renewal of the contract it shall deemed to have been terminated. The contract of engagement can be terminated at any time without assigning any reasons.
- iii. The Junior Engineer (Civil) so engaged will be eligible for a consolidated salary of Rs. 9,300/- (Nine Thousand Three hundred only) per month during the contract period without any allowance.
- iv. Refusal to accept the engagement will be treated as cancelled and the candidate shall be deemed to be forfeited his claims for future engagement as Junior Engineer under the Government of Odisha.
- v. The engagement is subject to verification of his character and antecedents and passing a test in Odia Language up to VII Standard.
- vi. The following certificates in original should be produced at the time of joining for verification.
 - a) H.S.C or equivalent certificate exhibiting the date of Birth and passing in Odia Language up to VII standard.
 - b) Diploma Certificate.
 - c) Caste Certificate in case of Reserve Category.
 - d) Physically handicapped / Sports / Ex-Serviceman Certificate wherever necessary.
 - e) Medical Certificate in proof of fitness from a Medical Officer not below the rank of Asst. Surgeon.
 - f) Two character Certificates from two Gazetted Officers of Government of Odisha not below the rank of Class – II.
 - g) Two recent passport size photographs duly attested.

- vii. This engagement is subject to signing the agreement in the prescribed formats attached herewith on the stamp paper worth Rs. 21/-.
- viii. The concerned person should join in his place of posting within 30 days from the date of issue of Order, failing which the order of engagement will be deemed to be cancelled unless and otherwise directed by the Government.
- ix. He should give a declaration to the effect that, he has not more than one spouse living at the time of joining.
- x. If the candidate is employed in any other Organization / Department he should submit the copy of order of his relief from the post which he is continuing at the time of his joining the new assignment.

AGREEMENT FOR ENGAGEMENT OF JUNIOR ENGINEER (CIVIL) ON
CONTRACTUAL BASIS UNDER WORKS DEPARTMENT.

This Deed of Agreement made on the _____ Day of _____ 2014.

BETWEEN

The Governor of Odisha represented through the Engineer-in-Chief (Civil), Odisha, Nirman Soudha, Bhubaneswar – 751001 or his authorized representative (hereinafter called as the party of the First Part).

AND

Miss / Smt. / Sri _____ Aged _____ son / Wife /
Daughter of _____ permanent resident of Village / Town - _____,
Po _____, Ps _____, Dist _____, Odisha, hereinafter
called as the party of the second part.

Whereas the Government of Odisha have decided to engage the junior Engineer (Civil) on contractual basis under Works Department and the party of the second part has agreed for engagement as Junior Engineer (Civil) on contractual basis on the terms and conditions appearing hereunder:

Now this agreement witnesses as follows :

- 1) That, the engagement of party of the second part shall be _____ up to 28.02.2014 A.N.
- 2) That, the engagement of the party of the second part may be terminated at any time by the party of the first part by giving one month's notice without assigning any reason thereof.
- 3) That, of the party of the second part wishes to leave the said engagement before the contractual period, he/she shall given one month's notice and in case one month's notice is not possible he / she shall repay one month's salary to the party of the first part.
- 4) That, the party of the second part shall be paid a consolidated salary of Rs. 9,300/- (Rupees Nine Thousand Three Hundred) second part is engaged, for a part of calendar month or remains absent other than casual leave or official duty without prior approval of the party of the first part or any other authority authorized by him in this behalf, the salary shall be reduced proportionately. The amount payable to the party of the second part shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.

- 5) That, the party of the second part shall ordinarily be permitted to avail casual leave up to 10 (Ten) days in a calendar year. In special circumstances, if so decided by the party of the first part Special Casual Leave to the extent of 5 (Five) days in a calendar year in addition to normal Casual Leave of 10 (Ten) days shall be allowed. Where term of appointment does not extend to a full calendar year, the casual leave/special casual leave shall be proportionate to the period or engagement. The casual leave/ special casual leave can not be claimed as a matter of right. Casual leave or Special Casual Leave combined with Special Casual Leave shall not be allowed for 10 days or more at a time inclusive of Sunday, Second Saturday and authorized Government Holidays. However, when exigency of public service so require, the Divisional Officer / Head of Office, where the party in the second part is working, has the discretion to refuse or revoke such leave.
- 6) That, the party of the second part will not leave the Headquarters without prior permission of the party of the first part or any other authority authorized by him in this behalf to avail Sunday / Holiday or Casual Leave.
- 7) There shall be no deduction in salary during the period of Casual Leave / Special Casual Leave / authorized Government Holidays.
- 8) The party of the first shall transfer the party of the second part as and when necessary in the interest of public works from one station to another station within the State of Odisha during the period of his engagement.
- 9) That, the party of the second part shall be entitled to avail minimum joining time as required for actual travel on her / his transfer.
- 10) That, the party of the second part during her / his engagement shall be responsible for and perform following duties in addition to any other duties as would be entrusted to her / him by the party of the first part or any other authority authorized by him in this behalf from time to time.
 - i. Timely and careful field survey and investigation and preparation of plans and estimate entrusted to their charge. Any mistake in sanctioned plans and any variation between the conditions at site and the sanctioned plan arise should be promptly brought to the notice of the Sub-Divisional Officer or the Divisional Officer

- concerned with a view to rectify getting the defects before actual execution of the work.
- ii. Timely and efficient execution of work entrusted to their charge.
 - iii. Proper maintenance of muster rolls and record of work-charged establishment.
 - iv. Proper upkeepment of measurement books issued to them.
 - v. Record of measurement in measurement books of all works done by contract or otherwise as well as supplies received from all sources and preparation and submission of bills in prescribed forms for payment.
 - vi. Proper preservation and care of tools and plants, stocks and other stores kept in their charge.
 - vii. Timely submission of budget, accounts and prescribed returns etc. to the Sub – Divisional Officer concerned.
 - viii. Correct assessment and prompt collection of revenue entrusted to their charge.
 - ix. To report immediately any un-usual extraordinary or peculiar occurrence arise connected with their sections to the Sub-Divisional Officers and other authorities as may be necessary.

The duties indicated above are illustrative and not exhaustive.

- 11) That, the party of the second part, if found responsible for any loss of Government money or property / tools and plants for the acts of omission or commission during his / her engagement, the cost of such Government property / money shall be recovered from his/her salary and if the salary is not sufficient for adjustment, the same shall be recovered from him / her by way of filing Civil Suits / Certificate Cases under the Odisha Public Demands Recovery Act, 1962 (Odisha Act I of 1963) as an arrear of land revenue along with the cost of Civil Suits or Certificate Case. Criminal action may also be taken against him / her for such misappropriation or loss of Government property etc.
- 12) That, the party of the second part shall at all time maintain absolute integrity, decorum of conduct and devotion to duty. He / She shall at all time carry out the orders and act according to the instruction of his/her superior so far as his official duties are concerned. He / She shall not engage himself / herself in any trade, vacation, business or any other gainful employment either full time or part time during the period of his / her engagement and shall abide by the provisions under the Odisha Government Servant's Conduct Rules, 1959.

13) That, in case of misconduct of the party of the second part during her / his contractual engagement, the same shall be enquired into by giving reasonable opportunity to the party of the second part to defend herself/himself and if she / he is found guilty, her / his engagement shall be terminated forthwith.

14) That, the party in the second part shall not claim for permanent absorption in the regular establishment in view of the present contractual engagement on the basis of this agreement.
